**SUB : PROPOSED 10 DAYS EDUCATIONAL TOUR TO AJANTA CAVES-ELLORA CAVES-AURANGABAD-PUNE-
MAHABALESWAR-PANCHGANI**

Tentative Dates being Saturday 09 May 20 to Monday 18 May 20

The BGES School (ICSE) organises a highly subsidised historical cum educational tour to the different regions of the country and outside. As in the previous year, this year too, the school will be organising a tour to Ajanta Caves-Ellora Caves-Aurangabad-Pune-Mahabaleswar-Panchgani.

MAXIMUM STUDENTS THAT CAN BE ACCOMMODATED ON THE TOUR IS 75 SELECTION OF STUDENTS WHO QUALIFY FOR THE TOUR AS PER SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN IN SCHOOL DIARY WILL TAKE PLACE ON FIRST COME FIRST BASIS

In view of the parents request the notice is being issued early to facilitate payment at their convenient time.

THE CLASSES PERMITTED TO OPT FOR THE TOUR AS PER THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20 WILL BE THE STUDENTS OF CLASSES 7-8 WHOSE NAMES APPEAR IN THE STUDENT'S LIST OF THE SAID CLASSES IN THE MONTH OF SEP 2019.

It is estimated that the cost of the trip for the student after a minimum 50% subsidy from the school side will range between Rs 10,000 to Rs 15,000 and will not exceed Rs 15,000. Due to time constraint, and the fact that the school has to do a lot of planning and work, there is a time constraint on payment for the tour. The rail tickets have to be bought four months in advance.

The parents will have to deposit through the standard procedure a sum of Rs 12,000/- on account of the Tour to be held in May 2020 by **31 Dec 2019. NO EXTENSION FOR REGISTRATION DATE OR DELAYED PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**

Registration to be done by submission of personal release cum consent form duly filled in all respects, (available in the School Soft 13.1) along with RS. 12,000 /- (Rupees Twelve Thousand Only) per child to be paid in Federal Bank latest by **Tuesday 31 Dec 2019** through the bank challan available in SS 13.1. The form and xerox of the Challan is to be deposited to the Class Teacher.

On finalisation of the tour costs the parents either will be returned excess payment or requested to pay the shortfall per student if necessary. Registration does not automatically mean eligibility for proceeding for the tour. The school shall put up a list of the students selected to proceed for the tour on the Notice Board.

The children whose names do not figure in the list will be refunded the amount deposited.

In case of cancellation or withdrawal of the child's name for any reason whatsoever, **NO** refund will be given, in case if the rail tickets have been purchased or if the hotel bookings have been done by the Tour Operator, whichever is earlier.

The above tour programme is tentative & subject to change.

The children on medication must produce their Fitness Certificate including details of medication.
