These instructions are meant for the following categories of candidates:

- 1. ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) EXAMINATION PCNA (Pass Certificate Not Awarded) CANDIDATES who wish to re-appear for the ICSE/ISC Examination to be held in the Year 2022.
- 2. ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) EXAMINATION PCA (Pass Certificate Awarded) CANDIDATES who wish to improve their grades in one or more subject/s.
- 3. ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) EXAMINATION ABSENT/WITHDRAWN CANDIDATE who wish to appear for the ICSE / ISC Year 2022 Examination.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES NOT AWARDED PASS CERTIFICATE / SUPPLEMENTARY CANDIDATES / ABSENT OR WITHDRAWN CANDIDATES

ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) EXAMINATION – PCNA (Pass Certificate Not Awarded) CANDIDATES

These candidates can:

- 1. APPEAR FOR THE ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) YEAR 2022 EXAMINATION AS CANDIDATES IN REGULAR ATTENDANCE (TYPE 1 CANDIDATES) AT THE SCHOOL FOR A FULL CERTIFICATE
- Candidates will have to be admitted to Class X of ICSE / Class XII of ISC, at a Council affiliated school and the entry of the candidates concerned will have to be confirmed with the CISCE through the online module.
- These candidates will have to follow the bifurcated syllabus.
- They will have to appear for the Examinations of Semester I and Semester II.
- 2. APPEAR FOR THE ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) YEAR 2022 EXAMINATION AS CANDIDATES NOT IN ATTENDANCE (TYPE 3 CANDIDATES) AT THE SCHOOL FOR A FULL CERTIFICATE

(Such candidates will be permitted to re-appear for the examination only once in the year following their failure, but not thereafter, without further attendance at a Council affiliated school).

- The entry of these candidates will have to be confirmed with the CISCE through the online module.
- These candidates will have to study the entire reduced syllabus (Semester I and Semester II) for the Year 2022 Examination.
- The Question Paper pattern for these candidates will be identical to the pattern of Question Paper followed for the ICSE / ISC Year 2021 Examination.
- The Examinations for these candidates will be conducted in the month of March/April 2022.

Note: It may be noted that this year a special provision that has been put in place for the Year 2022 Examination and should not be considered as a precedent for the future.

ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) EXAMINATION - PCA (Pass Certificate Awarded) CANDIDATES

(Candidates who were awarded Pass Certificates/Supplementary Pass Certificate at the ICSE / ISC Examination conducted in the Year 2021 or earlier, and want to improve their subject grade/s.)

These candidates can:

- 1. APPEAR FOR THE ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) YEAR 2022 EXAMINATION AS CANDIDATES IN REGULAR ATTENDANCE (TYPE 2 CANDIDATES) AT THE SCHOOL FOR A SUPPLEMENTARY CERTIFICATE
- Candidates will have to be admitted to Class X of ICSE / Class XII of ISC, at a Council affiliated school and the entry of the candidates concerned will have to be confirmed to the CISCE through the online module.
- These candidates will have to follow the bifurcated syllabus
- They will have to appear for the Examinations of Semester I and Semester II.
- 2. APPEAR FOR THE ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) YEAR 2022 EXAMINATION AS CANDIDATES NOT IN ATTENDANCE (TYPE 4 CANDIDATES) AT THE SCHOOL FOR A SUPPLEMENTARY CERTIFICATE
- The entry of these candidates will have to be confirmed with the CISCE through the online module.
- These candidates will have to study the entire reduced syllabus (Semester I and Semester II) for the Year 2022 Examination.
- The Question Paper pattern for these candidates will be identical to the pattern of Question Paper followed for the ICSE / ISC Year 2021 Examination.
- The Examinations for these candidates will be conducted in the month of March/April 2022.

Note: It may be noted that this is a special provision that has been put in place for the Year 2022 Examination as an exception and should not be considered as a precedent for the future.

(Please note, that the above two categories of candidates (Type 2 and Type 4) will be permitted to improve their grades in any/all of the subjects offered for the ICSE / ISC examinations earlier by the candidates provided that the subjects under consideration are still being offered for the examination in the year for which the candidates wish to appear).

ICSE (Class X) ISC (Class XII) EXAMINATION – ABSENT / WITHDRAWN CANDIDATES

These candidates can:

APPEAR FOR THE ICSE (Class X) / ISC (Class XII) YEAR 2022 EXAMINATION AS CANDIDATES IN REGULAR ATTENDANCE (TYPE 1 CANDIDATES) AT THE SCHOOL – FOR A FULL CERTIFICATE

- Candidate will have to be admitted to Class X of ICSE / Class XII of ISC, at a Council affiliated school and the entry of the candidates concerned will have to be confirmed with the CISCE through the online module.
- These candidates will have to follow the bifurcated syllabus
- They will have to appear for the Examinations of Semester I and Semester II.
